Anyone who violates this Code of Conduct may be sanctioned or expelled from these spaces at the discretion of Make+Think+Code.

- + Some of our events and spaces may have additional rules and policies in place, which will be made clearly available to participants. Participants are responsible for knowing and abiding by these rules.
- + We do not tolerate harassment or disrespect of participants in any form. Harassment includes but is not limited to offensive verbal or written comments related to gender, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, disability or illness, appearance, race, or religion; it includes use of violent, derogatory, or threatening language, imagery, gestures, behaviour, or comments, personal attacks, insults, incitement/encouragement of violence and harassment, deliberate intimidation, stalking, following, harassing photography or recording, sustained disruption of discussion, inappropriate physical contact or intimacy, creating a sexualised environment, and unwelcome sexual attention.
- + Damage to, theft of, or unapproved modifications of our technology and equipment are considered abusive behaviour and violations of the code fo conduct.
- + REPORTING: If you experience or observe discrimination, harassment, or violations of this code of conduct, please contact any Make+Think+Code staff associated with the event. We will respond as promptly as we can.
- + Consequences: Participants who are asked by anyone to stop any harassing or disrespectful behavior are expected to comply immediately.
